Program Description:

The It Works CNA/GNA training program is a 140-hour certificate program, which provides students with the training necessary to secure both their CNA and GNA licenses. The CNA/GNA program is broken into two components: (1) 120 hours of classroom/online classroom instruction and (2) 40 hours of virtual clinical training. All students must attend no less than 90% of the classroom (90 hours minimum) and 100% of the clinical hours (all 40 hours) to graduate.

Credential or Certification Earned:

CNA upon completion of the program, GNA after passing state board examination.

What do CNA/GNAs do?

CNAs and GNAs provide or assist with patient care in hospitals, nursing homes and home care under the direction of licensed nursing staff.

To be admitted to this program, you must:

- Complete and application and provide all required enrollment documents
- Attend an information session
- Be drug-free including marijuana
- Be physically able to complete all program requirements
- Have an acceptable criminal background
- Complete an online reading and math assessment
